

Call for NPSS Student Paper Awards

Mark your Abstract if Eligible before February 15th, 2011

The Pulsed Power Conference will honor the two best student papers.

Awards process

- a. Students will identify their abstracts as being eligible for consideration in the “NPSS Student Paper Award” competition when they submit their abstracts to the general conference abstract pool (the abstract form will have appropriate check boxes for sorting).
- b. Eligibility criteria:
 - i. The student must be the principal author of the paper or poster and must have performed the majority of the work.
 - ii. The work must be original.
 - iii. The submission needs to have the endorsement of the student’s research advisor (send to PPS&T Student Advocate by January 30th).
 - iv. Students should indicate whether they are IEEE members
 1. Membership is not a requirement, but in the event of a tie, preference will be given to the IEEE member.
 2. Students will be encouraged to apply for the free six-month IEEE Student Membership.
- c. Students will present their paper to the awards selection committee on Monday, June 20th, 2011, at 6:30 pm, at the Conference.
- d. The two best student papers will be awarded a certificate and \$500.- each, two runners up will receive a certificate.
